
San Diego is Here

The Reunion officially kicks off on Thursday, 4 May and ends Sunday, 7 May after our Chapel service to honor all our Shipmates who perished on the 407 during the Battle of Quadalcanal and those who have crossed the bar to Fiddler's Green since our last Reunion.

As in Reunions past, we will have a hospitality suite where you can gather with Shiomates from all years and sip on your favorite beverage. This year, due to contracts the hotels have with their unions, we can not provide free drinks, though we will have a cash bar.

Activities start Thursday, 4 May with daytime tours of the USS Midway Museum which is in close proximity to our hotels. If there is enough interest, I will have van transportation available.
